## **IRS Contribution Limit Remains the Same for 2020**

### For 2019\* and 2020, your total contributions to all of your traditional and Roth IRAs cannot be more than:

- \$6,000 (\$7,000 if you're age 50 or older), or
- your taxable compensation for the year, if your compensation was less than this dollar limit.

For 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, your total contributions to all of your traditional and Roth IRAs cannot be more than:

- \$5,500 (\$6,500 if you're age 50 or older), or
- your taxable compensation for the year, if your compensation was less than this dollar limit.
